Overview

The Optum Behavioral Health network supports members covered under UnitedHealthcare Individual Exchange Plan.

UnitedHealthcare Individual Exchange Plans, marketed as Individual and Family Plans, are built on patient-centered care, with the goal of enhancing the patient-doctor relationship and promoting better health and lower costs. Individual Exchange Plans place the focus on primary care, with members assigned a primary care provider (PCP) to help them manage their health care needs.

Plan names

1. Copay focus

- \$0 medical deductible
- · Copays for most services

2. Value

- · Our flagship plans with moderate deductibles but lower premiums
- Mix of copays and coinsurance
- Include additional benefits, such as pre-deductible coverage with copay, including low-cost Tier 2 generics

3. Advantage

- · Lower deductible with higher premium
- Copay cost-shares for many services
- May include extras, such as physical gym access

4. Standard

- Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and/or state-based marketplaces require all carriers to offer these plans
- Plan designs and cost-shares are prescribed, allowing consumers to more easily shop on price, network and product extras

5. Kelsey-Seybold

- Kelsey-Seybold Clinic providers are in-network for this plan and members have an assigned PCP from the clinic network
- Available in the Texas counties of Brazoria, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Montgomery and Walker

6. Essential

- · High deductibles and low premiums
- · Basic coverage for serious illness and injury
- Available off-exchange only: AZ, CO, MD, OH and TX
