Attestation for Supervision of Unlicensed and/or Pre-licensed Practitioners

In accordance with the Rocky Mountain Health Plans (RMHP) "Individual & Family Plans and Child Health Plan Plus: Billing for Unlicensed Practitioners" policy, effective August 1, 2023, licensed clinicians looking to supervise unlicensed and/or pre-licensed practitioners that fall under the guidelines of this policy must submit this attestation to RMHP to engage in supervision practices outlined by this policy.

Subsequent to the submission of the initial attestation, this attestation must be submitted to RMHP annually, no later than January 1 of each calendar year supervision may be rendered by the attesting organization. Organizations, groups, and facilities only need to submit one attestation for their entity; individual attestations for each licensed supervising clinician are not required. As per the policy, if an organization has already attested under the Medicaid Supervision of Unlicensed Practitioners, an additional attestation is not necessary.

By completing and returning this attestation to the RMHP, you acknowledge the following:

- You have read and understand the requirements and standards for both the licensed supervising clinician and the organization set forth in the Billing for Unlicensed Practitioners policy.
- You agree to maintain records of all documents required under the policy.
- You agree to provide any documents or records outlined under the policy upon request to RMHP within seven (7) business days of the request.
- You agree to hold RMHP and members harmless for nonadherence to this policy in any form, including but not limited to disputes between the attesting organization and any employees and/or contractors of the attesting organization.
- RMHP maintains the right to report any malfeasance impacting member care and/or licensure status
 to the appropriate state agencies, including the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing and
 the Department of Regulatory Agencies, in addition to internal actions RMHP may take to monitor
 and ensure quality of care.
- Failure to abide by the guidelines of this policy and/or any document requests from RMHP may result in the inability of your organization to supervise unlicensed or pre-licensed practitioners indefinitely.
- You agree to implement any updates made to the policy within the timelines dictated by the update.
- You have signatory authority and approval to submit this attestation for your organization.
